OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Apache County, St. Johns, Arizona
September 15, 1980

Meeting opened at 9:00 A.M. Ms. Dennison and Mr. Lee were present, with Ms. Dennison acting Chairman.

The September 9th Primary Election was canvassed and accepted as listed on the following pages. Motioned by Mr. Lee, seconded by Ms. Dennison.

There was discussion on the deferred prosecution program, after which the Board approved Resolution 80-14, for the purpose of applying for State Financial Assistance on the Deferred Prosecution Program. Motioned by Mr. Lee, seconded by Ms. Dennison.

There was discussion on the Self help Housing Program and their desire for continued Sponsorship by Apache County. After discussion the Board approved Resolution 80-13. It was noted that there is a self help program operating in Northern Apache County, which we do not sponsor. Motioned by Mr. Lee, seconded by Ms. Dennison.

The Board discussed the Office of Economic Development and Planning (OEDP) Plan for the coming year. There was a great deal of concern expressed over the quality of the Plan and over assurances given in the Plan. The Board approved the Plan with an amendment stating that the funding is not available for the St. Johns, New Mexico road. Motioned by Mr. Lee and seconded by Ms. Dennison.

There was discussion on the need to fill positions in two departments, which have been vacated. The Sheriff department has had a vacancy in the Puerto Region for one and half months and the Health Department has had a vacancy within their grant program. After the Board received assurances that all vacation had been used by the individual vacating the positions (or paid for) so there would be no overlap of payment made, they approved the filling of the positions.

Board went into executive session on a personnel matter.

The Board then canvassed the results of the Primary Election held September 9, 1980 and declared the following to be the official results.


