The Board then agreed that to comply with the minimum wage requirements, the compensation for Election Board workers should be \$31.00 for Inspectors and \$26.00 for all others.

The Board approved tax correction certificates waiving penalties on various personal property for the year 1959 through 1968 were also cancelled. The Assessor was also directed to assess back personal taxes on the Air-Mex Company for the past three years.

Lease purchase agreement with Hall Motors Inc. for a Diesel truck was signed.

Complying with Senate bill 1035, the Apache County Guidance clinic was accepted as the official screening agency for commitment of mentally disordered persons.

Approval was given for a state sponsored traffic safety study for the county. The study will be Federal and State funded, and will determine needs for signing and other deficiencies.
