

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
 Apache County, St. Johns, Arizona  
 November 3, 1980

Meeting was called to order at 9:20 A.M. Mr. Lee, acting chairman, Ms. Dennison present, Mr. Graymountain absent.

Minutes were approved as corrected to indicate Mr. Graymountain's arrival prior to the Road Use permit approval.

Executive Session was postponed to await Mr. Graymountain's presence.

Application for transfer of liquor license #80-B, Series 6, having been legally posted to be heard at this time was called. The application was for Don's Liquors to be on the premises designated as Road Runner Mobile Home Park and transferred from Donald J Hruska. There being no objections, it was moved by Ms. Dennison, seconded by Mr. Lee to approve the transfer. Vote was unanimous.

The Road Abandonment in the community of Greer was discussed. Supervisor Lee mentioned that he had received verbal communication from Jack Wiltbank in opposition to the abandonment. There was lengthy discussion. Stan Donovan, representative of the property owners, spoke in favor of the abandonment. Jess Broadbent, County Engineer, indicated he had researched the proposed action and was in agreement. Motion to abandon the following described section of roadway by Ms. Dennison, seconded by Mr. Lee. Resolution of Abandonment #80-15 described as, the West 216 feet of Greer Street in the town of Greer, Arizona.

Jesse Broadbent, County Engineer, discussed with the Board the design of the entrance of the access road to the Tuscon Electric Power Company plant site. The original design apparently was altered by the State Highway Department to the current design. The current design appears to create a confusing and dangerous situation. County Engineer has addressed a letter to the Arizona Department of Transportation.

Mr. Broadbent addressed the Board concerning the County making application for the entrance road to Park Show Low Unit 1, to the state. This has been previously discussed in Board meeting. Motion to apply by Ms. Dennison, seconded by Mr. Lee.

The Apache County Comprehensive Plan was discussed. The matter was tabled until the November 10th meeting to allow Howard Jackson, Planning & Zoning director to be present.

The Board canvassed the October 28th Recall Election in the Round Valley School District.
