October 4, 2022**

1. Discussion and possible approval of Amendment #1 to the Flu and Pneumonia Vaccination Services Agreement between the Apache County Public Health Services District, Arizona Local Government Employee Benefit Trust (AZLGEBT) and Rural Arizona Health Group Trust (RAGHT), replacing Section II(1)(A), Section II (5), Exhibit A and B, effective October 1, 2022.
2. Discussion and possible approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement Contract No. CTR060578 for immunization services, effective July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2027. This contract serves to increase immunization coverage levels of children 0-18 years of age and adults 19 and older, in the amount of \$50,000. This has been budgeted for in FY23.
3. Discussion and possible approval of the Governor's Office of Highway Safety Grant, effective October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023, in the amount of \$10,000. This grant helps purchase car seats and provides education on proper installation. This has been budgeted for in FY23.

County Manager/Clerk of the Board:

- *A. Request approval of demands as distributed to the Apache County Board of Supervisors between September 6, 2022, and October 4, 2022. Demands are payments made, or to be made, by the County. Specific details of the demands may be requested through the County public record request process.
- *B. Request approval of minutes dated September 6, 2022.

- *G. Request approval of a Conditional Use Permit allowing Michael & Toni Bragiel to store their personal travel trailer on their 0.72-acre property. Property is located in Greer, AZ 85927. A.P.N. 102-08-020B. Planning & Zoning commission recommended approval on March 10, 2022.

Election Department:

- *H. Request approval of all Election Board Workers, Poll Workers, Equipment Management and Election Day Technicians for the upcoming November 8, 2022 General Election.
- *I. Request approval of the designated polling places for the upcoming November 8, 2022 General Election.

2. Sheriff's Office: Discussion and possible approval of the Governor's Office of Highway Safety STEP Enforcement Overtime grant in the amount of \$5,000. This has been budgeted for in FY23.
3. Sheriff's Office: Discussion and possible approval of Franchise Agreement with Commnet Wireless, LLC regarding the use of Right-of-way to install fiber optic cable. This agreement does not affect the FY23 budget.
4. Emergency Management: Discussion and possible approval of an extension to Grant #SFA 19-104 from Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management for the rewrite of the Apache County Community Wildfire Protection Plan, through June 30, 2023.
5. Call to the Public: Individuals may address the Board on any relevant issue for an amount of time determined by the Chairman. At the close of the call to the public, Board members may not respond to any comments but may respond to criticism, ask staff to review a matter or ask that a matter be placed on a future agenda.
