In 2021, Apache County and Coalition members the cities of Eagar, Holbrook, Pinetop-Lakeside, Springerville and St Johns were awarded a \$600,000 U.S. EPA (EPA) Brownfields grant to support the assessment, cleanup planning, and revitalization of publicly and privately-owned underutilized properties (sites). Grant funds can be used to complete Phase I and II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs), cleanup planning, and a variety of property reuse planning activities. Funding will be available for use likely through summer 2024, for approximately 14 high priority Phase I ESA sites and 8 high priority Phase II ESA sites.
